Marathon Terrain: Mostly grassy tracks

Marathon Course: Section B only, all divisions/classes. Modified course for VSE and Small Pony entries.

Cones Ring/Warm-up area Footing: Grass/Packed Sand.

Other Information

Veterinary/Health Requirements: Negative Coggins within 1 year of show date; out of state entries require a health certificate to enter State of Florida

Stabling Information: Some Permanent Stabling. Temporary Stabling with Stall doors.

Driver/Groom twice around allowed on marathon? (Article 943.2) Participation on course twice only, subject to scheduling requirements. Only requests included with entry form will be considered.

Misc. Show info: All dogs must be leashed at all times. Loose dogs will be kept for you at the show office. There is a \$50 fee to collect your dog.

Awards Offered: First place ribbon to winners for each combination of division/turnout/class for Dressage and Marathon presented Saturday evening. Cones first place and overall division winners presented after classes in arena on Sunday. Overall division awards available only to those competing in all three competitions in the same division.

Directions to Show: From I-75 North: At Gainesville, exit onto Highway 24 West (Archer Road) to Bronson. Go 19 miles, turn left at light on Alt. US 27, go .4 miles turn right on CR 337, Black Prong is 8.5 miles on the right. From I-75 South: At Ocala, turn left on US 27 North. Go 7.2 miles and turn left on CR 464B West (Shell Station across on right) Go 8.5 miles, turn right on US Highway 41 North. Go 2.5 miles turn left on on CR 326 West. Follow for 8.5 miles and turn right on CR 337 North. Black Prong is 2.5 miles on the left.
