Longview Horse Park (LVHP) is a beautiful first class dedicated equine horse park situated along the shores of Longview Lake. The course terrain is grass with dirt/grass trails through the woods and is very hilly. Total vertical elevation change over the trails is 1024 foot. The trails have several small creek crossings, some of which are bridged and some are not. The facility has 8 permanent obstacles.
