Natural creek crossings on course for all levels -- designated creek crossing area may be schooled only in-hand Thursday at posted times. Please check at office for creek schooling.

Veterinary/Health Requirements: To promote health and welfare of all horses, Equestrians Institute complies with ADS rules regarding horse welfare including but not limited to vaccination requirements. (Art 6.3) Vaccination recording form available at All equines (except Washington, Oregon, and Idaho) require negative Coggins from no longer ago than May 19, 2016. Vet certificate required for horses coming into Washington State. Please check with your vet for particulars, as state requirements may change. Biosecurity measures are followed at all EI events.
