Entry/Class Fees: \$210 (EI members \$190); **Post Entry Fees:** \$260

Entry Fee Refund Policy: \$50 office fee will be deducted from all refunds. Before closing date, full refund minus office fee. After closing date up until 72 hours before event starts, full refund minus office fee only if can backfill from waiting list. No refunds after 72 hours prior to event start.

Test(s):

Training: Test #4 POM for all turnouts;

Preliminary: Test #4 POM for singles and pairs,
Test #5 POM for multiples

Intermediate: Canter test #1 for singles and pairs,
Test #7 for multiples

Advanced DT: FEI Test #3*B HP1 for singles;
FEI Test #3*B HP2 for pairs;
FEI Test #3*B HP4 for four-in-hands

Ring/Warm-up area Footing: Flat, level grass/grass

Other Dressage Info:

- Pony and horse singles, pairs and all Training -- 40x80 arena;
- Pony and horse Intermediates, Advanced, and multiples other than Training -- 40x100;
- VSE singles and pairs and all Training -- 30x60 arena;
- VSE Intermediates, Advanced, and multiples other than Training -- 30x75;
- Safety check 15 minutes prior to Dressage

Marathon

Terrain: Pasture, forest trails, dirt and gravel roads. Can be bumpy in places. Not many hills. Several natural creek crossings. Wildlife may be encountered.

Training: all turnouts: 3 sections; 8-12 km total; 4-5 obstacles, each with 3 gates

Preliminary: all turnouts: 3 sections; 8-14 km total; 5-6 obstacles, each with 4 gates

Intermediate: all turnouts: 3 sections; 10.8-15 km total; 6-7 obstacles, each with 5 gates

Advanced DT: all turnouts: 1 section, up to 10 km total; 6-7 obstacles, each with 6 gates

Other: Water obstacle(s) for Preliminary, Intermediate, and Advanced. Natural creek crossings on course for all levels -- may be schooled in-hand on Thursday at posted times.

Cones

Ring/Warm-up area Footing: Grass / Grass

Training, Preliminary, Intermediate: Minimum clearances by class and vehicle width per Article 973.1.7

Advanced DT: Standard vehicle track widths and clearances per FEI -- See table under Article 974. VSEs refer to Article 973.1.9.

Other: No bridges or water crossings for Cones. Planned opening for course inspection by 6 p.m. Saturday. Order of go may be determined by track width.

Other Information

- **Veterinary/Health Requirements:** To promote health and welfare of all horses, Equestrians Institute complies with ADS rules regarding horse welfare including but not limited to vaccination requirements. (Art 6.3)
 - Vaccination recording form available at <https://www.usef.org/documents/membership/EquineVaccinationRecord.pdf>
 - All equines (except Washington, Oregon, and Idaho) require negative Coggins from no longer ago than May 19, 2016. Vet certificate required for horses coming into Washington State. Please check with your vet for particulars, as state requirements may change.
 - Biosecurity measures are followed at all EI events.

- **Stabling Information:** In-barn stalls. Limited number of small stalls for VSEs available. Two VSEs or small ponies may share one stall. Tack stalls may or may not be available. Please plan accordingly. Daily haul-in in lieu of stall(s) is allowed -- \$25 fee for weekend per entry. Self-stabling may be allowed in designated area only if barn is full -- \$25 fee for weekend per entry. Please indicate special preferences with your entry.

- **Driver/Groom twice around allowed on marathon?** Competitors and navigators may compete more than once ONLY IF schedule permits. Sharing of equipment, navigators, multiple goes – subject to advance scheduling. Request must be included with your entry form to be considered.

- **Misc. Show info:**
 - Limited number of golf carts available for rental, first come, first served. Enter and reserve early for best chance at getting one. \$155 for a cart that seats two; \$235 for a cart that seats four. Please send separate check made out to EI. Your check will be returned if we're sold out by the time you enter.
 - No lunging in camping/parking area.
 - Please turn off generators after 10 p.m.
 - Stalls and camping/parking spots to be assigned. Please list preferences on entry form and we will do our best to accommodate.

- **Awards Offered:** Ribbons through fifth place. Special merit awards and special breed awards. Classes may be combined for awards.
- **Food Available on the Grounds:** Yes. Concessions for breakfast and lunch Friday, Saturday, Sunday.
- **Accommodations:** Choice of motels nearby, 5 to 20 minutes away. Contact organizer for more information.
- **Camping On Grounds:** Yes, no hook ups.
- **Camping Off Grounds:** Yes. Ike Kinswa Campground in Silver Creek, WA. 11.5 miles (14 minutes) east of Ethel on Mayfield Lake.
- **Directions to Show:** 1489 US Hwy 12: From I-5, take Exit 68 (Highway 12 east, toward Yakima), go east 7 miles. Venue entry is on the left -- look for arch at driveway. Westbound traffic on Highway 12 -- entry is on right at mile 73.5 (½ mile past Shell Station at Leonard Road intersection).
