After crossing river, at Jct SR 252 (3rd stoplight) turn left onto Old Hospital Rd (may see signs for Camp Atterbury). Go 3 miles and turn right into Johnson County Park on Schoolhouse Rd. Go 9/10 mile, turn left onto 31st St. Go past the covered arena, turn left into Compound to Barns I-J-K-L. Watch for signs. Office located next to Restrooms near Barns.
