General Information

IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ: We strongly suggest that ALL competitors have someone riding on the carriage with them at ALL times. ALL COMPETITORS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A GROOM ON THE CARRIAGE FOR CONES. There will be no daily haul-ins permitted. All competitors are required to take a stall. There will be a special award for the Best Turned Out at the 1st Horse Inspection. Trophy and six ribbons will be awarded for each class. Other special awards for dressage and marathon. ALL stalls must be vacated by 7:30 AM Monday morning or a \$50 layover fee will be charges. (KHP Rule)

Other Information

Negative Coggins within 1 year of show date. A copy of your Coggins Test MUST be submitted with your entry. Health Certificate dated within 30 days of competition, horses residing with the state of KY may have a KY Health Certificate dated within 1 year of show date. Proof of Flu and Rhino vaccinations are required for ALL entries. Please send copies of vaccinations, coggins test, measurement card, ADS Membership Card and USEF Membership Card in with your entry. If you enter online, please send the additional information to the show secretary prior to arriving at the event. This will help to expedite the check-in process. FEI all horses/ponies must be properly registered and identifiable by diagram.
