### Type of Events/Divisions offered

CAC

Drivers have the option to select all competitions in the same division or cross-enter between divisions.

Driver must be eligible for each division/competitions entered (see 913.3).

Driving Trial entry – on CAC entry form select any one Dressage test, any one Marathon, and one Cones competition.

Combined Test entry – on CAC entry form select any one Dressage test, “none” Marathon, and any one Cones competition.

Entry limit - drivers may enter either of two DT, two CT or one DT and one CT – use separate CAC Entry Forms for each entry.

Second entry, if same horse/pony/VSE at this event: Dressage must be different tests or second as H/C; Marathon one competition only; Cones must be different class or second as H/C.

Entry acceptance: Completed entries must be legible, signed and include applicable fees, deposits and copies of membership and horse papers; and be received by closing date.

Organizer reserves the right to refuse any entry; modify the schedule; or combine or cancel any classes.

- Training Test 2 POM (80m)\*
- Training Test 4 POM (80m)\*
- Preliminary Test 2 POM (80m)\*
- Preliminary Test 4 POM (80m)\*
- Intermediate Test 7 (100m)
- Intermediate II - singles - FEI 3\*B HP1 (100m)
- Intermediate II - pairs - FEI 3\*B HP2 (100m)
- Intermediate II - fours - FEI 3\*B HP4 (100m)

\* Tandems and four-in-hands in 100m arena; VSE classes plan 30m x 60m arena.

Other Dressage Information -

**Maximum of two entries per driver** (use separate CAC Entry Forms)

**Second entry, if same equine** must select a different dressage test or specify one to be H/C.

**Dressage arena / warmup area footing:** Grass arena / warmup grass, packed sand.

**All scheduling/sharing requests** must be indicated clearly on entry forms and are subject to scheduling requirements.

**Note:** All vehicles to be wheel-measured at dressage warm up before competing.

## Marathon

---

CAC Marathon:

Select one from the following list per entry:

- Training - Section B only, maximum: obstacles. 5, gates 3, approximate distance up to 6km (reduced for VSE and small ponies)

- Preliminary – Section B only, maximum: obstacles 6, gates 4, approximate distance up to 7km.
- Intermediate – Section B only, maximum: obstacles 7, gates 5, approximate distance up to 8km.

Marathon Terrain - Flat tracks, grass, discarded bedding on some wooded trails, compacted sand/dirt roads

Additional Considerations/Comments -

**Twice around limitation:** any shared combination of driver/groom/navigator/carriage may participate a maximum of twice on Marathon.

Request must be indicated clearly on both driver's CAC entry forms.

**Second entry:** any horse/pony/VSE may participate once only on Marathon at this event.

**All sharing requests** must be indicated clearly on both driver's entry forms to be considered and are subject to management discretion and scheduling requirements.

**Safety check:** all entries must turn in completed Safety Checklist to safety inspector 15 minutes prior to starting Marathon.

- Training - Standard Cones setting per table 973.1.8. Class speeds: 975.9.5
- Preliminary - Standard Cones setting per table 973.1.8. Class speeds: 975.9.5
- Intermediate - Standard Cones setting per table 973.1.8. Class speeds: 975.9.5
- Intermediate II - Standard Cones settings per table 974.1 and class speeds per table 974.9.5

Arena/Warm Up Footing: Grass paddocks

Cones Comments:

**Proceed to Cones warmup** area immediately following Dressage test.

**Any changes to turnout** must be reported to TD prior to competing.

**Second entry, if same equine** must select different Cones divisions or specify one entry to be H/C

**All sharing requests** must be indicated clearly on both driver's entry forms to be considered and are subject to management discretion and scheduling requirements.

Directions to Show - **From I-75 North:** At Gainesville, exit onto Highway 24 West (Archer Road) to Bronson. Go 19 miles, turn left at light on Alt. US 27, go .4 miles turn right on CR 337, Black Prong is 8.5 miles on the right.

**From I-75 South:** At Ocala, turn left on US 27 North. Go 7.2 miles and turn left on CR 464B West (across from Shell Station on right) Go 8.5 miles, turn right on US Highway 41 North. Go 2.5 miles turn left on CR 326 West. Go 8.5 miles and turn right on CR 337 North. Black Prong is 2.5 miles on the left.

## General Information

---

**Membership:** Driver must be a current ADS member or EC Sport License holder or pay the ADS non-member fee \$30.

**Special needs, sharing and scheduling requests:** must be indicated clearly on CAC entry form before closing date to be considered. Subsequent additions/changes after closing date may incur late fee charges.

**Equine Health Requirements:** Confirm expiry dates with your Veterinarian. Equines must be accompanied by valid:

1. equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months;
2. negative Coggins test within 12 months of January 16, 2017;
3. health certificate (for out-of-state horses) within 14 days.

**Dogs must be on leash** at all times while outside on site. Nuisance or loose dogs will be impounded; retrieval fine: \$50.

**Awards:** All entries are eligible for 1st place ribbons for each division/turnout/class. Dressage and Cones presented at Saturday evening bonfire. 1st place Marathon and Overall awards to 6th place for eligible entries completing all three competitions in the same division presented in the Pavilion approximately one hour after Marathon.
