Veterinary/Health Requirements: Health certificate within 30 days for out of state horses. West Nile Vaccination highly recommended. Influenza required for Advanced level per USEF rules. Negative Coggins within 1 year of show date for out of state horses.

Stabling Information: 10 X 10 covered stabling with doors, Driver/Groom twice around allowed on marathon? (Article 917) Yes. Competitors and/or Navigators, or any combination thereof, may go a MAXIMUM of 2 times on course, schedule permitting. In order to go twice around, Organizer must be notified via email by October 1, 2013. No requests after October 1, will be honored.

Misc. Show info: Food concession for lunch on grounds. Please provide copies of USEF and ADS membership cards with your entry. Please provide copy of pony measurement card with entry. Passports are not required however, if no passport is available, competitor must provide a means of identification of the horse/pony for the horse inspection.

Directions to Show: Located near Lodi, California at the corner of Hwy. 12 and Interstate 5 ("Flag City" exit). 16175 N. Ray Road, Lodi, CA 95242. **FROM THE BAY AREA:** Take 580 East from San Francisco, through Hayward, Pleasanton, Livermore, over the Altamont Pass (the group of hills between Livermore & Tracy covered with windmills). Between Livermore & Tracy, 580 veers off to the right (toward Modesto) - do not veer to the right, STAY LEFT (or straight) - the highway turns into 205 and takes you on to Tracy. After passing through Tracy, 205 merges onto 1-5 Northbound. From that point it's another 20-25 minutes into Stockton from Tracy. Continue traveling North on 1-5 until you reach the Highway 12 Exit. Go east towards Lodi. Take the immediate left onto Thornton Road (frontage road past the Flying J). The entrance to the CDE is approximately 1/2 mile down on the right. Watch for signs. **FROM SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA:** Travel North on 1-5 until you reach the Highway 12 Exit (approx. 10 miles above Stockton). Go east towards Lodi. Take the immediate left onto Thornton Road (frontage road past the Flying J). The entrance to the CDE is approximately 1/2 mile down on the right. Watch for signs. **FROM SACRAMENTO:** Travel I-5 South (toward Los Angeles). Lodi is approximately 40- 45 minutes south of Sacramento. As you approach Lodi, exit East on Highway 12 toward Lodi, going under freeway. Take the first left onto Thornton Road (frontage road past the Flying J). The entrance to the CDE is approximately 1/2 mile down on the right. Watch for signs.
