Reservations must be made with entry. ATV-type vehicles allowed however organizing committee reserves the right to request anyone driving in an inappropriate manner or tearing up the grounds to leave the competition; licensed drivers only permitted to drive motorized vehicles on the grounds; all dogs must be leashed; competitors encouraged to bring a fm radio as sound system can be transmitted through a local channel; MCDE committee and vet recommend that all equines be shod and conditioned for the marathon.
