From New York and New England: Take Rt. 287 to Exit 22. Follow directions from * above.

From south or west: Take Rt. 78 to Rt. 287. Follow directions from * above.

From north or west: Take Rt. 80 to Rt. 206 South. Go to light at Pottersville/Gladstone intersection (approximately 12 miles); turn right onto Pottersville Rd. Follow ** above.
