Directions to Show - from the south: Route 287 to exit 22B (Route 206N - Bedminster) \*\* Proceed north on 206 to light at Pottersville Road (approx. 4.5 miles) Turn left onto Pottersville Road and IMMEDIATELY after the turn make a left turn onto Fowler Road (dirt) Looki for sign for stables on left. From New York or New England Take Route 297 to exit 22 and follow the directions from \*\* above From the South or West Take Route 78 to Route 287 and follow the directions above From the North or West Take Route 80 to Route 206 South. Go to the light at Pottersville Road and turn Right and IMMEDIATELY turn left onto Fowlers Road
