In order to go twice around, Organizer must be notified via email by August 1, 2017 at the latest. Any requests made after August 1 will not be honored. Carriages may be shared ONLY IF SCHEDULE PERMITS. Equines may compete one time only. Misc. Show info: On-site stabling is mandatory. \* PLEASE NOTE: There will be no hauling in or out of horses during the Marathon phase of the competition on Saturday, August 27. The gates will be closed to trucks and trailers except in the case of an emergency, and will be assisted by the Barn Manager.
