If the sharing is not indicated on the entry form, then a \$50 sharing charge will be assessed. Further more, the organizer reserves the right to refuse any entry or sharing accommodation, or to combine or cancel any classes. On Site camping must be self contained. NO HOOK UPS on site!!

Additional Considerations/Comments - Driver/groom/carriage twice around allowed on marathon according to Article 943.2 if schedule permits and not in the same division. BUT must be noted on your entry form. Every effort will be made, however, those sharing should arrange for extra help and be prepared to make an equipment changes in a short time. There will be no changes of this after closing date unless a fee of \$50. Section A and Walk may only be inspected by walking or biking. Section B is on your own with ATV, Golf carts--NO CARS. There will be a "MULE CRAWL course walk of Section B Friday evening. No motor vehicles on course once marathon starts.

If we get a large number of entries and not enough neighborhood stabling, we will then provide tent stabling close by for everyone at which there will be a charge of \$125 for stalls for the weekend. We will be in contact a couple of weeks before if this has to be done.
