From New York or New England Take Route 297 to exit 22 and follow the directions from \*\* above From the South or West Take Route 78 to Route 287 and follow the directions above From the North or West Take Route 80 to Route 206 South. Go to the light at Pottersville Road and turn Right and IMMEDIATELY turn left onto Fowlers Road

**General Information**

All dogs must be leashed at all times. Loose dogs will be kept for you at the show office. There is a \$50 fee to collect your dog. Participation on course "twice only" for drivers, navigators, or equipment, subject to scheduling requirements. Only requests included with entry form will be considered. Wheel track measurement required on Entry Form and will be verified at dressage. Only authorized vehicles will be allowed in Pine Meadow on Sunday, May 20th during the Marathon. A valid drivers license is required to operate any motorized vehicle on the grounds.
