**Drivers have the option** to select all competitions in the same division (such as everything Preliminary) or cross-enter between divisions (such as Training dressage, Intermediate cones, Preliminary marathon).**The CAC format event** is described under 901.10.6. Use the CAC Entry Form**Driver must be eligible** for each division/competitions entered (see 913.3).**CDE or Driving Trial entry** – select any one Dressage test, any one Marathon, and one Cones competition. Decide day to compete for dressage/cones**Combined Test entry** – select any one Dressage test, "none" Marathon, and any one Cones competition.**Entry limit** - drivers may enter either of two DT, two CT or one DT and one CT – use separate CAC Entry Forms.**Second entry, if same equine** at this event: Dressage must be different tests or second as H/C; Marathon one competition only; Cones must be different class or second as H/C.**Entry acceptance:** Completed entries must be legible, have all blanks filled out and include applicable fees, deposits and copies of membership and horses paper; and must be received by closing date. Incomplete entries are subject to a late fee for materials or payments submitted after closing. After closing date, mailed/paper entries are not accepted - they must be emailed and paid online.

### Marathon

CAC Marathon: Select one from the following list per entry:

- CDE Training – Maximums: obstacles 5, gates 3, distance 12km
- CDE Preliminary – Maximums: obstacles 6, gates 4, distance 13km. (reduced for VSE and small ponies)
- CDE Intermediate – Maximums: obstacles 7, gates 5, distance 14km (reduced for VSE and small ponies).

- DT Training – Section B only, Maximums: obstacles 5, gates 3, approximate distance 7km
- DT Preliminary – Section B only, Maximums: obstacles 6, gates 4, approximate distance 8km. (reduced for VSE and small ponies)
- DT Intermediate – Section B only, maximums: obstacles 7, gates 5, approximate distance 9km (reduced for VSE and small ponies).

**Twice around limitation:** any shared combination of driver/groom/navigator/carriage may participate a maximum of twice on Marathon. Request must be indicated clearly on both driver's CAC entry forms.  
**Second entry:** any equine may participate once only on Marathon at this event.

**All sharing requests** must be indicated clearly on both driver's entry forms to be considered and are subject to management discretion and scheduling requirements.

**Safety check:** all entries must turn in completed Safety Checklist to Start of marathon 15 minutes prior to starting Marathon.

### Other Information

**Equine Health Requirements:** Confirm expiry dates with your Veterinarian. Equines must be accompanied by valid:

1. equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months of show end date;
2. Negative Coggins test within 12 months of show end date;
3. health certificate (for out-of-state horses) within 14 days.
