Hotel 1 - Multiple hotels in Decatur and Bridgeport.

Directions to Show - From Fort Worth: go north on Interstate 35W to US Hwy 287W (towards Decatur/Bridgeport). Follow 287 approx. 12 miles and exit at Texas Hwy 114W (Rhome/Boyd/Bridgeport). Go west approx. 10 miles to FM 51; exit right and go left/south under overpass. Follow FM 51 about 1 mile and turn right/west on FM 2123 (towards Cottdale). Go 3 miles and turn left/south on CR 3585 (corner gas station on right). When road Ts (1 mile) turn right. At the left curve, turn right into driveway. North Texas Whip sign at entrance.

General Information

Management reserves the right to refuse any entry. Dogs must be kept on leash and controlled. Owners must clean up doggy deposits. Loose dogs will be impounded, \$25 fee to retrieve dog. No motorized vehicles except golf carts allowed on marathon course, no vehicles (unless driven by an event official or medical personnel) allowed on course during the marathon, no exceptions.
